Rutgers Business School is proud to announce that the 38th World Continuous Auditing & Reporting Symposium will be held on November 4 and 5, 2016 at Rutgers Business School in Newark, New Jersey. The special emphasis this year will be **Analytics in Auditing and Accounting**. We invite you to attend this leading forum for the discussion of research and practice into the application of technology to auditing and reporting. In particular, this year's conference will highlight the recently announced Rutgers AICPA Data Analytics Research Initiative (RADAR), which seeks to develop automated techniques and data analytics to apply to the financial statement audit. The symposium brings together researchers, vendors and implementers of new and innovative accounting related technology. Topics include, but are not limited to:

The information presented is at a detailed technical level and is meant to provide participants with a thorough update of the latest products and research. The intended audience of the conference is internal and external auditors, CPAs who are working with continuous auditing and other new AIS technologies and academics undertaking research in these areas. Prerequisites and advance preparation are not required. The symposium offers 14 CPE credits via group live delivery method based on a 50 minute credit hour (3 CPE credits in accounting and 11 CPE credits in auditing will be awarded).
